



Solano County Project Roomkey Intake Process

HIGH-RISK CLIENT (not COVID+ or PUI)

All "high-risk" referrals to Project Roomkey should be made by Resource Connect Solano: 707-652-7311, RCS@Caminar.org

65+ and/or chronic health condition

Fill out FEMA Assessment Form; Client fills out self-certification of high-risk status

Age 60-64 and no chronic health condition

Fill out non-FEMA Assessment Form

Other

Not within "high-risk" Project Roomkey Prioritization. Fill out non-FEMA Assessment Form

- Arrange transport
- Store belongings (if more than 2 large bags)
- Send form & self-certification (if req) with client to project.

COVID+ or PUI (symptomatic)

COVID+/PUI motel rooms are only available in Vallejo. All COVID+/PUI referrals should be made directly to the Vallejo Project.

COVID +

Fill out FEMA Assessment Form; if possible, include written medical verification of positive test.

Person Under Investigation

Fill out FEMA Assessment Form; if possible, include written medical verification of exposure.

Symptomatic

Fill out FEMA Assessment Form; medical assessment and verification completed at project by medical staff

- Arrange transport
- Store belongings (if more than 2 large bags)
- Send form & medical verification (if possible) with client to project.

DEFINITIONS

COVID+:

People who test positive for COVID-19 that do not require hospitalization, but need isolation or quarantine (including those exiting from hospitals).

PERSON UNDER INVESTIGATION (PUI) (FEMA Definition)

Persons who have been exposed to COVID-19 (as documented by a state or local public health official, or medical health professional) that do not require hospitalization, but need isolation or quarantine;

Symptomatic per CDC: (symptoms should be above normal baseline)

- Cough;
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing;
- Fever;
- Chills;
- Muscle pain;
- Sore throat;
- New loss of taste or smell.
